

## ***Noodletools Assignment***

1. Go to the Carroll Home Page and then to the Library databases page. From there find Noodletools. Open the database and choose *create a Personal ID* from the choices. It will ask you to provide a password which is patriot. When the screen opens again, you will fill in the form for the **Personal ID please enter your entire student number with your initials at the end.** Example name: Claire Jones ID# 20110601. The personal id would be 20110601cj. You may use any password. Please make sure that the last four digits of your phone number are valid. **If you lose your password you need both your personal ID and your phone number, it is important that they are valid as the school doesn't have access to your account after it is set up.**
2. Once your account is setup you are going to open a new list. Name the list after the author you were assigned. For this assignment you will be using Noodletools to create three bibliographic entries and three note cards.
  - a. One bibliographic entry and note card is to come from the GVRL and the *Encyclopedia of World Biography*. Remember the home password for this site is carroll. The note card should include the following information
    - i. The genre for which the author is best known
    - ii. His birthplace
    - iii. Remember to make sure that the persistent link works.
    - iv. YOU must provide a "works cited" entry
  - b. The next bibliographic entry is to come from EBSCOHOST. Open EBSCOHOST, remember the passwords for this site are User name: carroll and password: patriot. When you open Ebscohost web, make sure to search both Masterfile Premier and Masterfile School Ultra. Look for your author; find an article that is NOT a review of the author's work. The note card here should include
    - i. The article abstract
    - ii. Remember to make sure that the persistent link works
    - iii. YOU must provide a "works cited" entry
  - c. The final bibliographic entry is to come from ACCESSPA and should be a book about the author that you can borrow. The note card here should include:
    - i. Two sources (libraries) that have the book.
    - ii. Remember this bibliographic entry will be done as if you had the book not as a web source.
3. When you have completed the assignment, you must submit it electronically to me, by sharing the list.
