Archbishop John Carroll High School encourages students to become involved in the life of the school community by participating in the world of activities and athletics. This is primary to the mission of Archbishop Carroll High School which is to educate the total person: academically, spiritually, physically, and socially. We are proud of our extra-curricular program; we boast over 25 clubs and activities, and 27 sports teams.

Over 70% of our student population participates in activities including the school newspaper, theatre productions, chorus, student council, NHS, Best Buddies, Pro Life and Mock Trial, just to mention a few. The many clubs we offer at Carroll have a strong influence on the Carroll experience. Without activities Carroll just would not be the same. To be able to provide extra curricular activities for our students requires much more than the funds available from fees collected with the tuition. For this reason, the Office for Student Affairs conducts two major fundraisers that go strictly to the operations of the ACTIVITIES PROGRAM. Our 2 fundraisers are the Fall Magazine Discount Card Drive, and Doggie Bingo, which began on Monday May 5, 2008.

Deeds for 6 plots were given to each student through homeroom. Deeds will be accepted each day of the Spring fundraiser in the Office for Student Affairs. The grand prize is \$2,500.00, and we are offering an incentive of \$100.00 to the highest seller. Each student is requested to sell 6 deeds at \$5.00 per deed, totaling \$30.00.

We encourage everyone to participate in our Spring Fundraiser in some capacity. This year not only have we set personal selling quotas, but we have set a school community quota. Students achieving the personal quota will be awarded a free day on Monday, May 19th. If we reach our school goal, the entire school will be awarded that day off.
