Elective Courses that Require Supplemental Materials  
2020-2021 School Year**

**Please follow the directions in the Updated Course Selection Materials in how to submit these materials as part of your Course Selection. The deadline for all materials is Wednesday, April 8<sup>th</sup>, by 11:59PM.**

1. **Honors Journalism and Creative Writing** - Each student must submit a 300-400-word essay, double-spaced, explaining why they hope to get out of this course, and what strengths they will bring to the class. If no essay is submitted, the student loses their spot in the class. No exceptions.
2. **Athletic Training / Sports Medicine (SENIORS ONLY)** - Each student must submit a 300 - 500-word essay (minimum one-page, double spaced, typed) as to why they wish to take this course and what they hope to get out of the course. NOTE: This course is offered on a CP Level ONLY. If no essay is turned in, students will lose their spot in the course. No exceptions.
3. **Media Production (For students who have not taken Broadcast Journalism prior)** - Students must submit a video they have shot and edited themselves to show experience with a camera and editing. Video should be a minimum of one minute in length, and must be submitted via e-mail to Mr. Devin Gallagher ([DGallagher@Jcarroll.org](mailto:DGallagher@Jcarroll.org)) no later than April 8th. If a student does not submit a video, they will not be accepted into the class. The video can be one that was used for a previous class.
4. **Honors Digital Photography (SENIORS ONLY)** - Students must submit three photos that they have taken to show their ability to operate a camera properly and their desire to take photos and understand more about the concepts that come with photography. Photos should be attached to an e-mail and sent to Mr. Devin Gallagher ([DGallagher@jcarroll.org](mailto:DGallagher@jcarroll.org)) by April 8th. If photos are not submitted by then, the student will lose their spot in the course. No exceptions.
5. **Honors Piano Lab** - Each student must submit a 300 - 500-word essay (minimum one-page, double spaced, typed) as to why they wish to take this course, their experience with playing piano, and what they hope to get out of the course. If no essay is turned in, students will lose their spot in the course. No exceptions.

6. **Faith in Action 11 and Faith in Action 12** - Students wishing to enroll in the Faith in Action Courses as a Junior or Senior must complete the following essay prompts:
  - a. What are some of your own personal gifts and strengths that you will share with/in the Faith in Action class?
  - b. What are you hoping to get out of the Faith in Action Class?
  - c. Essays should be typed, and double-spaced. They should be between 300 and 400 words. If no essays are submitted, a student will lose their opportunity to enroll in the course. No exceptions.
  
7. **Principles of the Exceptional Learner** - Students wishing to enroll in this course must provide a 300-500 word essay as to why they wish to take this course and what they hope to get out of the course. At the end of the essay, please list the two teachers who you would count as references. Recommendations do not need to be submitted, just the teacher names.
